

## News in brief: Grünewald produces 100 per cent recycled MG paper

Since early February German packaging paper producer Grünewald Paper has been producing machine glazed kraft paper made from 100 per cent recycled fiber. Until then, the company used to produce MG kraft paper from unused pre-consumer recovered fibre and virgin-fibre pulp. The company explained that despite the 100 per cent recycled fibre content it was able to maintain the papers' technical values and parameters by selecting high-quality recovered paper grades. This also means that the company's recovered paper suppliers have adopted a more extensive sorting process for kraft-containing grades to select the raw materials suitable for Grünewald Paper, the company said.
